



Grass Island Marina Maintenance Dredging GREENWICH, CONNECTICUT

Cashman was contracted to dredge and remove silt material as part of a maintenance dredging effort for the Town of Greenwich.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Cashman removed 3,498 cubic yard of silt material that was processed in a scow with Portland Cement and transported to New Haven, CT where it was offloaded and placed in an approved upland facility.
- Cashman also removed an additional 21,530 cubic yards of silt material that was transported offshore to the Central Long Island Disposal Site.
- Equipment utilized for offshore disposal was the *Wood II* dredge, an SEI 2000 dump scow, and the *Eddie Carroll* dump scow.
- Equipment utilized for upland disposal was the *Wood II* dredge, the *Michelle D.* hopper, the SEI 2001 dump scow, and the SEI 2003 dump scow.
